Application Roadmap

- Choose a Designated Learning Institution and target program.
- Receive your Letter of Acceptance and review tuition timelines.
- Prepare proof of funds, identity documents, and study plan.
- Submit your study permit application with complete supporting evidence.

Financial Planning

- Estimate tuition, housing, food, transport, and health coverage.
- Keep funds available and traceable in accepted financial formats.
- Plan for seasonal expenses and emergency reserve costs.

After Arrival

- Complete enrollment steps and maintain full-time student status.
- Follow work-hour rules and provincial health registration requirements.
- Build relevant experience through internships and student networks.
